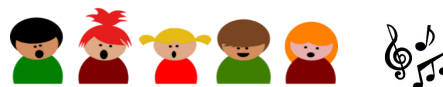






# Worship Time – November 29

A.P.C. Nursery Ministry – Sunday Morning Worship, Ages 2-4



	Materials	Finger Plays, Songs & Activities
 <p><b>Welcome</b></p>		<p><i>Good morning! We are so glad that we are together today. Today is Sunday. It is the "Lord's Day!" Let's worship Him together!</i></p> <p><b>Finger Play - Here is the church</b> (make church with hands)</p> <p><i>Let us greet one another as we begin our "Worship Time!" together.</i></p> <p><b>Welcome Song: "Good Morning to You!"</b> (fill in with child's name)</p>
 <p><b>Singing</b></p>	Rhythmic Instruments	<p>If you have any instruments, get them ready to sing and play.</p> <p><i>Let's worship God together with singing! The Bible tells us to "come and sing praises to God." Let us sing together, using our voices and instruments.</i></p> <p><b>Songs: "God is so Good" ("He Cares for Me"..., "He Loves Me so"...) "This is the day"</b></p> <p><b>Hymns of the month: "Joy to the World" and "Away in a Manger"</b></p>
 <p><b>Bible Story</b></p>	<p>Read Isaiah 40:1-11</p> <p><u>Look for an email:</u> Listen to and watch a video of lighting the advent wreath. The Hope candle.</p> <p>Also included: a weekly coloring page and sometimes a craft idea.</p> <p><i>(if you are not getting these emails, please contact Erin.)</i></p>	<p>Hold up a Bible and say, <i>The Bible is God's Word and it is true! I will pass the Bible around for you to hold in your hands. You can also open the Bible to see God's Word.</i></p> <p><b>Bible Memory Verse:</b> Read it aloud and have the children say it with you.</p> <p>Tell the children the aim and attribute: <b>Lesson Aim:</b> to know that God promised Jesus and that Jesus loves me. <b>Attribute:</b> We will see that <b>Jesus is Immanuel – God with us.</b></p> <p>Open the Bible to today's Bible Story, Isaiah 40:1-11 <i>Today's Bible story is about God's promises give us hope. Read from the Bible story book today's lesson.</i></p> <p><b>Bible Truth</b> (Review at the end of the story)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• God cared for his people long ago.</li> <li>• God promised Jesus.</li> <li>• Jesus came as God promised.</li> <li>• God cares for us now.</li> </ul> <p><b>Gospel connection:</b> God promised a Savior way back in Genesis. This Savior would make the wrong and hurt of sin right again. God sent Jesus to be with us, to right the wrongs of sin and to give us life. Immanuel is a name of Jesus. Immanuel means God with us! Thank you, Lord, for sending Jesus and for being with us today!</p> <p><b>Ask the children:</b> Does God always keep his promises? What does the name Immanuel mean? Is God with us right now?</p>
 <p><b>Prayer &amp; Closing</b></p>		<p><b>Closing Prayer</b> <i>Lord God, We thank You for teaching us that you are Immanuel through our Bible Story today. We thank You that You love us. Thank You for Jesus. Thank You for the Bible. Thank You for our church and for this time of worship! In Jesus Name, Amen.</i></p>
