	Materials	Finger Plays, Songs & Activities
 <p>Welcome</p>		<p><i>Good morning! We are so glad that we are together today. Today is Sunday. It is the "Lord's Day!" Let's worship Him together!</i></p> <p>Finger Play - Here is the church (make church with hands)</p> <p><i>Let us greet one another as we begin our "Worship Time!" together.</i></p> <p>Welcome Song: "Good Morning to You!" (fill in with child's name)</p>
 <p>Singing</p>	Rhythmic Instruments	<p>If you have any instruments, get them ready to sing and play.</p> <p><i>Let's worship God together with singing! The Bible tells us to "come and sing praises to God." Let us sing together, using our voices and instruments.</i></p> <p>Songs: "God is so Good" ("He Cares for Me" ..., "He Loves Me so" ...) "This is the day"</p> <p>Hymn of the month: "Praise Him, Praise Him"</p>
 <p>Bible Story</p>	<p>Beginner's Bible Pgs. 314-317</p> <p><u>Look for an email:</u> Listen to and watch a video of this Bible Story.</p> <p>Also included: a weekly coloring page and sometimes a craft idea.</p> <p><i>(if you are not getting these emails, please contact Erin.)</i></p>	<p>Hold up a Bible and say, <i>The Bible is God's Word and it is true! I will pass the Bible around for you to hold in your hands. You can also open the Bible to see God's Word.</i></p> <p>Memory Verse: Read it aloud and have the children say it with you. <i>"Jesus is the Son of God" Acts 9:20</i></p> <p>Tell the children the aim and attribute: Lesson Aim: To trust Jesus because he is the Son of God.</p> <p><i>In this story we will see that Jesus is trustworthy (Attribute)</i></p> <p>Open the Bible to today's Bible Story, John 2: 1-11 <i>Today's Bible story is about how Jesus turned water into wine. Read from the Bible story book today's lesson.</i></p> <p>Bible Truth (Review at the end of the story)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jesus showed his power as God's Son. • Jesus changed water into wine. <p>Ask the children: <i>Why could Jesus turn water into wine? Can you name something Jesus has done for you?</i></p> <p>Gospel Connection: Jesus performed his first miracle turning water into wine. He showed his power through a miracle and made others glad. Jesus performed other miracles too through God's power. After Jesus died on the cross and was buried, God's power was shown again when Jesus was raised from the dead, defeating death and sin and giving us the opportunity to live forever with Him. Knowing this makes our hearts glad! Thank you, Jesus, that we can trust you and know you!</p>
