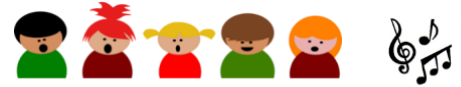






Worship Time – February 21

	Materials	Finger Plays, Songs & Activities
 <p>Welcome</p>		<p><i>Good morning! We are so glad that we are together today. Today is Sunday. It is the "Lord's Day!" Let's worship Him together!</i></p> <p>Finger Play - Here is the church (make church with hands)</p> <p><i>Let us greet one another as we begin our "Worship Time!" together.</i></p> <p>Welcome Song: "Good Morning to You!" (fill in with child's name)</p>
 <p>Singing</p>	Rhythmic Instruments	<p>If you have any instruments, get them ready to sing and play.</p> <p><i>Let's worship God together with singing! The Bible tells us to "come and sing praises to God." Let us sing together, using our voices and instruments.</i></p> <p>Songs: "God is so Good" ("He Cares for Me" ..., "He Loves Me so" ...) "This is the day"</p> <p>Hymn of the quarter: "Praise Him, Praise Him"</p>
 <p>Bible Story</p>	<p>Beginner's Bible Pgs. 462-465</p> <p><u>Look for an email:</u> watch a video of this story!</p> <p>Also included: a weekly coloring page and sometimes a craft idea.</p> <p><i>(if you are not getting these emails, please contact Erin.)</i></p>	<p>Hold up a Bible and say, <i>The Bible is God's Word and it is true! I will pass the Bible around for you to hold in your hands. You can also open the Bible to see God's Word.</i></p> <p>Bible Memory Verse: Read it aloud and have the children say it with you. <i>"We love because he first loved us." 1 John 4 :19</i></p> <p>Tell the children the aim and attribute: Lesson Aim: to follow Jesus by trusting, loving and obeying him. <i>In this story we will see that God is amazing. (Attribute)</i></p> <p>Open the Bible to today's Bible Story, John 21:1-14 <i>Today's Bible story is about how Jesus and the fishermen.</i> Read from the Bible story book today's lesson.</p> <p>Bible Truth (Review at the end of the story)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jesus taught the people. • Jesus showed his power over nature. <p>Ask the children: <i>How did the fishermen trust and obey Jesus? And what did they catch? Can we trust and obey him too?</i></p> <p>Gospel Connection: <i>God is amazing! Because we know this, lets trust him, love him, and obey him! Jesus has power over nature. When he came to earth, he did many miracles and amazing things that we cannot do ourselves. Most of all he died on the cross for our sins, something we could not do, because He loves us so much, Lets love him and trust obey him like the disciples did in that fishing boat!</i></p>
 <p>Prayer & Closing</p>		<p>Closing Prayer <i>Lord God, We thank You for teaching us that you want us to trust you, love you, and obey you through our Bible Story today. We thank You that You love us. Thank You for Jesus. Thank You for the Bible. Thank You for our church and for this time of worship! In Jesus Name, Amen.</i></p>
