	Materials	Finger Plays, Songs & Activities
 <p>Welcome</p>		<p><i>Good morning! We are so glad that we are together today. Today is Sunday. It is the "Lord's Day!" Let's worship Him together!</i></p> <p>Finger Play - Here is the church (make church with hands)</p> <p><i>Let us greet one another as we begin our "Worship Time!" together.</i></p> <p>Welcome Song: "Good Morning to You!" (fill in with child's name)</p>
 <p>Singing</p>	Rhythmic Instruments	<p>If you have any instruments, get them ready to sing and play.</p> <p><i>Let's worship God together with singing! The Bible tells us to "come and sing praises to God." Let us sing together, using our voices and instruments.</i></p> <p>Songs: "God is so Good" ("He Cares for Me" ..., "He Loves Me so" ...) "This is the day"</p> <p>Hymn of the month: "Praise Him, Praise Him"</p>
 <p>Bible Story</p>	<p>Beginner's Bible Pgs. 371-374</p> <p><u>Look for an email:</u> Listen to and watch a video of this story.</p> <p>Also included: a weekly coloring page and sometimes a craft idea.</p> <p><i>(if you are not getting these emails, please contact Erin.)</i></p>	<p>Hold up a Bible and say, <i>The Bible is God's Word and it is true! I will pass the Bible around for you to hold in your hands. You can also open the Bible to see God's Word.</i></p> <p>Bible Memory Verse: Read it aloud and have the children say it with you. <i>"We love because he first loved us." 1 John 4:19</i></p> <p>Tell the children the aim and attribute: Lesson Aim: to know that Jesus cares for his children.</p> <p><i>In this story we will see that Jesus heals people. (Attribute)</i></p> <p>Open the Bible to today's Bible Story, John 9:1-12 <i>Today's Bible story is about how Jesus healed a blind man. Read from the Bible story book today's lesson.</i></p> <p>Bible Truth (Review at the end of the story)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The man was born blind. • Jesus healed him so he could see. • The healed man and the people praised God. <p>Ask the children: <i>Have you ever been sick? When Jesus makes us well, what can we say to praise him? Did you know that Jesus cares for you?</i></p> <p>Gospel Connection: When Adam and Eve sinned, sickness, sadness, and broken body parts, like eyes, and even death entered the world. Many people get sick. There are many people born blind or lame because of sin. When Jesus came to die on the cross, he broke the curse of sin. That doesn't mean all sickness and illness disappeared from this life, but instead, when we trust Jesus as our Lord and Savior, we are spiritually healed. We can look forward to a never-ending life with Him in heaven, where our bodies will be new and healed too!</p>
 <p>Prayer & Closing</p>		<p>Closing Prayer <i>Lord God,</i> <i>We thank You for teaching us that you are God and can heal us through our Bible Story today. We thank You that You love us.
