|  <p>Welcome</p> | | <p><i>Good morning! We are so glad that we are together today. Today is Sunday. It is the "Lord's Day!" Let's worship Him together!</i></p> <p>Finger Play - Here is the church (make church with hands)</p> <p><i>Let us greet one another as we begin our "Worship Time!" together.</i></p> <p>Welcome Song: "Good Morning to You!" (fill in with child's name)</p> |
|  <p>Singing</p> | Rhythmic Instruments | <p>If you have any instruments, get them ready to sing and play.</p> <p><i>Let's worship God together with singing! The Bible tells us to "come and sing praises to God." Let us sing together, using our voices and instruments.</i></p> <p>Songs: "God is so Good" ("He Cares for Me"..., "He Loves Me so"...) "This is the day"</p> <p>Hymn of the quarter: "Christ the Lord is Risen Today"</p> |
|  <p>Bible Story</p> | <p>Beginner's Bible Pgs. 357-363</p> <p>Look for an email: watch a video of this story!</p> <p>Also included: a weekly coloring page and sometimes a craft idea.</p> <p><i>(if you are not getting these emails, please contact Erin.)</i></p> | <p>Hold up a Bible and say, <i>The Bible is God's Word and it is true! I will pass the Bible around for you to hold in your hands. You can also open the Bible to see God's Word.</i></p> <p>Bible Memory Verse: Read it aloud and have the children say it with you. <i>"Your word is truth." John 17:17</i></p> <p>Tell the children the aim and attribute: Lesson Aim: to trust Jesus because he loves and cares for us.</p> <p><i>In this story we will see that God provides. (Attribute)</i></p> <p>Open the Bible to today's Bible Story, Mark 6:30-44 <i>Today's Bible story is about how Jesus fed many people with a little boy's lunch. Read from the Bible story book today's lesson.</i></p> <p>Bible Truth (Review at the end of the story)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jesus was loving and helpful to the needy. • Jesus made a lot of food out of five loaves and two fish. <p>Ask the children: <i>God provided food for hungry people. How has he provided for you and your family?</i></p> <p>Gospel Connection: Jesus performed so many miracles, and this one is amazing story about caring for people daily needs. What is one thing we need each day that Jesus gave these people? Food. Jesus loved helping people in need. We should also try to find ways to love others and help where we can. Jesus still provides for all we need. We can pray to him knowing that He provides.</p> |
