Welcome		Good morning! We are so glad that we are together today. Today is Sunday. It is the "Lord's Day!" Let's worship Him together! Finger Play - Here is the church (make church with hands) Let us greet one another as we begin our "Worship Time!" together. Welcome Song: "Good Morning to You!" (fill in with child's name)
Singing	Rhythmic Instruments	If you have any instruments, get them ready to sing and play. Let's worship God together with singing! The Bible tells us to "come and sing praises to God." Let us sing together, using our voices and instruments. Songs: "God is so Good" ("He Cares for Me", "He Loves Me so") "This is the day" Hymn of the quarter: This is the Day
Bible Story	Beginner Bible: pgs. 50-52 Look for an email: watch a video of this story! Also included: a weekly coloring page and sometimes a craft idea. (if you are not getting these emails, please contact Erin.)	Hold up the small Bible and tell children, The Bible is God's Word and it is true! I will pass the Bible around for you to hold in your hands. You can also open the Bible to see God's Word. Bible Memory Verse: Read it aloud and have the children say it with you. "I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart." Psalm 9:1 Tell the children the aim and attribute: Lesson Aim: to know that God loves, cares for and rescues His people. In this story we will see that God rescues his people. (Attribute) Open the Bible to today's Bible Story, Exodus 1-2 Today's Bible story is about the Birth of Moses Read from the Bible story book today's lesson. Bible Truth (Review at the end of the story) God cared for baby Moses. Moses became the son of the king's daughter. God prepared Moses to help God's people. Ask the children: How did God rescue baby Moses? Who else did God use to save baby Moses? Gospel Connection: The story of Moses points us to Jesus. In both stories there were mean kings who wanted to kill all the baby boys to get rid of Moses and Jesus. In both stories, baby Moses and baby Jesus grow up to be used by God to help save his people. Moses helped to lead the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt and Jesus saved us all from slavery by dying on the cross for our salvation. God rescues his people!
