Welcome		Good morning! We are so glad that we are together today. Today is Sunday. It is the "Lord's Day!" Let's worship Him together! Finger Play - Here is the church (make church with hands) Let us greet one another as we begin our "Worship Time!" together. Welcome Song: "Good Morning to You!" (fill in with child's name)
Singing	Rhythmic Instruments	If you have any instruments, get them ready to sing and play. Let's worship God together with singing! The Bible tells us to "come and sing praises to God." Let us sing together, using our voices and instruments. Songs: "God is so Good" ("He Cares for Me", "He Loves Me so") "This is the day" Hymn of the quarter:
Bible Story	Beginner Bible: Pgs. 111-115 Look for an email: watch a video of this story! Also included: a weekly coloring page and sometimes a craft idea. (if you are not getting these emails, please contact Erin.)	Hold up the small Bible and tell children, The Bible is God's Word and it is true! I will pass the Bible around for you to hold in your hands. You can also open the Bible to see God's Word. Bible Memory Verse: Read it aloud and have the children say it with you. "I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart." Psalm 9:1 Tell the children the aim and attribute: Lesson Aim: to know that God saves his people In this story we will see that God is Lord over all. (Attribute) Open the Bible to today's Bible Story, Exodus 3, 13-15 Today's Bible story is about Moses at the Red Sea. Read from the Bible story book today's lesson. Bible Truth (Review at the end of the story) God remembered his promise to his people. God sent Moses to lead God's people out of Egypt. God showed his glory, "I am the Lord." Salvation is from God. Ask the children: Can you make water move like God did, so the Israelites could walk on dry land? No! Only God can do that. He is Lord over all! Gospel Connection: God promised to rescue his people, the Israelites, and he did. Moses was his helper. In Genesis, God promised to rescue the whole world through a Savior, the Messiah. What was his name? Jesus! God is the Lord – the ruler, the one in charge of everything. He knows His plan and carries it out. He is Lord over all.
