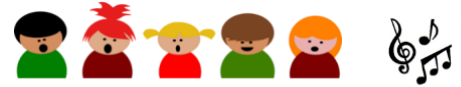






Worship Time – June 27

	Materials	Finger Plays, Songs & Activities
 <p>Welcome</p>		<p><i>Good morning! We are so glad that we are together today. Today is Sunday. It is the "Lord's Day!" Let's worship Him together!</i></p> <p>Finger Play - Here is the church (make church with hands)</p> <p><i>Let us greet one another as we begin our "Worship Time!" together.</i></p> <p>Welcome Song: "Good Morning to You!" (fill in with child's name)</p>
 <p>Singing</p>	Rhythmic Instruments	<p>If you have any instruments, get them ready to sing and play.</p> <p><i>Let's worship God together with singing! The Bible tells us to "come and sing praises to God." Let us sing together, using our voices and instruments.</i></p> <p>Songs: "God is so Good" ("He Cares for Me"..., "He Loves Me so"...) "This is the day"</p> <p>Hymn of the quarter:</p>
 <p>Bible Story</p>	<p>Beginner Bible: Pgs.116-119</p> <p>Look for an email: watch a video of this story!</p> <p>Also included: a weekly coloring page and sometimes a craft idea.</p> <p>(if you are not getting these emails, please contact Erin.)</p>	<p>Hold up the small Bible and tell children, <i>The Bible is God's Word and it is true! I will pass the Bible around for you to hold in your hands. You can also open the Bible to see God's Word.</i></p> <p>Bible Memory Verse: Read it aloud and have the children say it with you. <i>"Teach me to do your will, for you are my God." Psalm 143:10</i></p> <p>Tell the children the aim and attribute: Lesson Aim: to know that God takes care of us every day and to thank Him for our "daily bread."</p> <p><i>In this story we will see that God is our Provider. He gives us what we need. (Attribute)</i></p> <p>Open the Bible to today's Bible Story, Exodus 16 <i>Today's Bible story is about how God Gave Manna.</i> Read from the Bible story book today's lesson.</p> <p>Bible Truth (Review at the end of the story)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • God's People needed food to live. • God gave His people manna. • God cared for them every day. • God wants his people to trust and love him. <p>Ask the children: <i>What things do you think you need? How did God provide - or gives what they needed - for his people? Can we trust Him to provide for us too?</i></p> <p>Gospel Connection: The Israelites needed food, water and a safe place to sleep. God provided manna for them as well as quail and water. We need those things too. They help to keep our physical bodies alive. But we also need things that we can't get for ourselves. We are sinners and we needed a Savior. Jesus came to be our Savior. God provided Jesus to meet a need that we could never do ourselves. Thank you, God, for providing our Savior, Jesus! We need to trust and love him just like God wanted the Israelites to do!</p>
 <p>Prayer & Closing</p>		<p>Closing Prayer</p> <p><i>Lord God, We thank You for teaching us that God is our Provider through our Bible Story today. We thank You that You love us. Thank You for Jesus. Thank You for the Bible. Thank You for our church and for this time of worship! In Jesus Name, Amen.</i></p>
