	Materials	Finger Plays, Songs & Activities
 <p>Welcome</p>		<p><i>Good morning! We are so glad that we are together today. Today is Sunday. It is the "Lord's Day!" Let's worship Him together!</i></p> <p>Finger Play - Here is the church (make church with hands)</p> <p><i>Let us greet one another as we begin our "Worship Time!" together.</i></p> <p>Welcome Song: "Good Morning to You!" (fill in with child's name)</p>
 <p>Singing</p>	<p>Rhythmic Instruments</p>	<p>If you have any instruments, get them ready to sing and play.</p> <p><i>Let's worship God together with singing! The Bible tells us to "come and sing praises to God." Let us sing together, using our voices and instruments.</i></p> <p>Songs: "God is so Good" ("He Cares for Me" ..., "He Loves Me so" ...) "This is the day" Hymn of the quarter:</p>
 <p>Bible Story</p>	<p>Beginner Bible: Pgs. 190-193 or Jesus Storybook Bible: pgs. 130-135</p> <p><u>Look for an email:</u> watch a video of this story!</p> <p>Also included: a weekly coloring page and sometimes a craft idea.</p> <p><i>(if you are not getting these emails, please contact Erin.)</i></p>	<p>Hold up a Bible and say, <i>The Bible is God's Word and it is true! I will pass the Bible around for you to hold in your hands. You can also open the Bible to see God's Word.</i></p> <p>Bible Memory Verse: Read it aloud and have the children say it with you. <i>"I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart." Psalm 9:1</i></p> <p>Tell the children the aim and attribute: Lesson Aim: to know that God wants us to sing praises to Him. <i>In this story we will see that God is worthy of our praise. (Attribute)</i></p> <p>Open the Bible to today's Bible Story, I Samuel 16-17 <i>Today's Bible story is about the Songs of David. Read from the Bible story book today's lesson.</i></p> <p>Bible Truth (Review at the end of the story)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • God chose David to be king someday. • David loved God. • David protected his father's sheep. • David sang praises to God. <p>Ask the children: <i>What songs do you know that we can sing to praise God?</i></p> <p>Gospel Connection: God chose David to be king one day. David protected his sheep well and loved God. Jesus is our King. Jesus is the Good Shepherd. Jesus showed his obedience and love for God when he died on the cross for us. The Bible also tells us that Jesus was a descendant of king David and fulfilled the promise that another King would come to rule forever. King Jesus is also worthy of our praise, love and obedience.</p>
 <p>Prayer & Closing</p>		<p>Closing Prayer <i>Lord God, We thank You for teaching us that you are worthy of our praise through our Bible Story today. We thank You that You love us.
