Welcome		Good morning! We are so glad that we are together today. Today is Sunday. It is the "Lord's Day!" Let's worship Him together! Finger Play - Here is the church (make church with hands) Let us greet one another as we begin our "Worship Time!" together. Welcome Song: "Good Morning to You!" (fill in with child's name)
Singing	Rhythmic Instruments	If you have any instruments, get them ready to sing and play. Let's worship God together with singing! The Bible tells us to "come and sing praises to God." Let us sing together, using our voices and instruments. Songs: "God is so Good" ("He Cares for Me", "He Loves Me so") "This is the day" Hymn of the quarter:
Bible Story	Beginner Bible: Pgs. 120-123 Look for an email: watch a video of this story! Also included: a weekly coloring page and sometimes a craft idea. (if you are not getting these emails, please contact Erin.)	Hold up the small Bible and tell children, The Bible is God's Word and it is true! I will pass the Bible around for you to hold in your hands. You can also open the Bible to see God's Word. Bible Memory Verse: Read it aloud and have the children say it with you. "Teach me to do your will, for you are my God." Psalm 143:10 Tell the children the aim and attribute: Lesson Aim: to learn that the Bible tells us how to live and about our need for Jesus. In this story we will see that God is perfect. (Attribute) Open the Bible to today's Bible Story, Exodus 19-20 Today's Bible story is about how God Gave Moses the Law. Read from the Bible Story book today's lesson. Bible Truth (Review at the end of the story) God talked to Moses. God gave His people ten commands. God told his people how to worship and live. Ask the children: How many commands did God give? Can we ever be perfect and do them all? Who is the only perfect one? Gospel Connection: God gave the Israelites the 10 Commandments – the rules to follow. These rules were given to show how to worship and how to live. We should follow these commands, but also recognize that we cannot follow them completely or all the time. When Jesus came to earth, he lived a perfect life – in other words He is the ONLY one who has ever completely followed these 10 commands! Because he was perfect, he could be our Savior!
