Worship Sequence	Materials	Finger Plays, Songs & Activities
 <p>Welcome</p>	<p>“Worship Time!” Binder</p>	<p>Help children put toys away & invite them to sit in the circle for "Worship Time." Sing a "Clean Up" song to help kids transition.</p> <p><i>Welcome boys and girls! We are so glad that you are here today. Today is Sunday. It is the "Lord's Day!" We have come to church, the "Lord's House" to worship Him together!</i></p> <p>Finger Play - Here is the church (make church with hands) <i>Let us greet one another as we begin our "Worship Time!" together.</i></p> <p>Welcome Song: "Good Morning to You!" (fill in with child's name)</p>
 <p>Singing</p>	<p>“Worship Time!” Binder</p> <p>Rhythmic Instruments</p> <p>Look for the QR code in the binder to play the songs.</p>	<p>Pass out rhythmic instruments.</p> <p><i>We have all come to our church this morning to worship God together. The Bible tells us to "come and sing praises to God." Let us sing together, using our voices and instruments.</i></p> <p>Songs: "God is so Good" ("He Cares for Me" ..., "He Loves Me so" ...) "This is the day" Hymn of the quarter: "He's got the whole world in His Hands"</p>
 <p>Bible Story</p>	<p>“Worship Time!” Binder</p> <p>Small Bible (black)</p> <p>Beginner's Bible Pgs. 26-33</p> <p>Coloring page Crayons</p> <p>Coloring page – please send home with child</p>	<p>Hold up the small Bible and tell children, <i>The Bible is God's Word and it is true! I will pass the Bible around for you to hold in your hands. You can also open the Bible to see God's Word.</i></p> <p>Bible Memory Verse: Read it aloud and have the children say it with you. <i>"Immanuel – which means, 'God with us.' " Matthew 1:23</i></p> <p>Tell the children the aim and attribute: Lesson Aim: Today we are going to learn that God always keeps his promises.</p> <p><i>In this story we will see that God keeps his promises. (Attribute)</i></p> <p>Open the Bible to today's Bible Story, Genesis 7-9 <i>Today's Bible story is about Noah and the ark.</i> Read from the Bible story book today's lesson.</p> <p>Bible Truth (Review at the end of the story)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • God promised to never destroy the whole world again with a flood. • The rainbow was a sign of God's promise. <p>Gospel connection: God sent the flood to punish the world for sin, but God rescued Noah and his family. He put a rainbow in the sky to remind us of his promise to never destroy the world again by a flood. Later, there was an even greater rescue! Jesus came to save people from sin. If we trust in Jesus, He saves us from the punishment of our sin.</p> <p>Ask the children: <i>Have you ever seen a rainbow in the sky? Every time you see one, say thank you to God that He keeps his promises.</i></p> <p>Catechism Review: Questions <i>See Catechism page in folder.</i></p>
